

## Part A. Cutting and Layout, continued . . .

### 5. Making the neck draw

- (a.) Position fabric wrong side up.
- (b.) Fold **short sides**  $1/2"$  and double fold a second one-half inch to eliminate raw edges – press in place and sew to reinforce edges.



- (c.) Fold **long sides** together to make center crease – press. Open up and re-fold each long side to center – fold and iron in place.



## Part B. Adding Neck Draw & Binding

### 1. Attaching Neck Draw.

On bag fabric measure down  $3 1/2"$  from top (unnotched) and draw a chalk line.

Align the **neck draw** below the line and centered on the Snuggie – sew each long side in place . . . sewing approximately  $1/8"$  from edge.



### 2. Attaching binding to top of piece

- (a.) Place binding on "right" side of outer layer, open (raw) edge of binding aligned with the top (raw) edge of the snuggie. Sew using  $1/2"$  seam allowance.
