

## Part A. Cutting and Layout - continued

2. Lay the main fabric, batting and lining wrong sides together – pin (adhere in place). (see Picture >)

Machine quilt as desired.  
Square up and cut quilted piece 11" x 15 1/2"



3. Find the center of the bag (main fabric)
- Draw a chalk line from top to bottom. On bottom corners of main fabric, mark a 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" inch square.
  - Using center chalk line mark a 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangle from the center bottom edge. **Make sure that you mark 1 1/4" on each side of center chalk line to ensure your cut out is centered.** (See Picture)
  - Then cut out center rectangle and marked corners

4. **Making binding** for top of Snuggie. Place wrong side up, fold fabric in half, together, and press.
